



## Cumberland Valley High School Track and Field Booster Club

The Katelyn John “Shining Light” Scholarship is a \$1000 scholarship that exemplifies the Track and Field tradition of education and athletic achievement. It is awarded to one Cumberland Valley High School Senior on the CV Track and Field Team who exhibits a positive attitude to teammates and their community. The athlete must have participated a minimum of two years, including their senior year. The applicant must be pursuing college upon graduation.

To apply for this scholarship, submit to the high school guidance office:

- Essay explaining in your own words why you are seeking this scholarship and your future plans upon graduation. Your letter should describe how you have contributed as a leader in your community and as a positive role model to others.
- Completed Scholarship Application
- Copy of your most recent transcript issued by the Guidance Department
- Letters of recommendation (optional)

Katelyn John was a 2005 graduate of Cumberland Valley High School and a 4-year member of the CV track team. She broke multiple class and school records in many sprinting and jumping events. She especially enjoyed both the individual and team aspects of relays where she could usually be seen running the anchor leg with her trademark braids flying behind.
