The Eagle Foundation is a non-profit organization that works to provide additional educational opportunities for students within the Cumberland Valley School District (CVSD). After more than 20 years of service, we remain committed to providing financial resources that **inspire learning, enrich teaching, and create opportunities** for the educators and students of CV.

Since 1996, we have invested more than \$4.6 million in creative projects outside of the traditional state, local, and federal sources to support innovative instruction and facilities. Within the 2016-17 fiscal year, because of the generosity of parents, residents, alumni, and business partners, the Foundation expects to invest \$210,000 in direct service expenditures to support key programs for the benefit of our CV students.

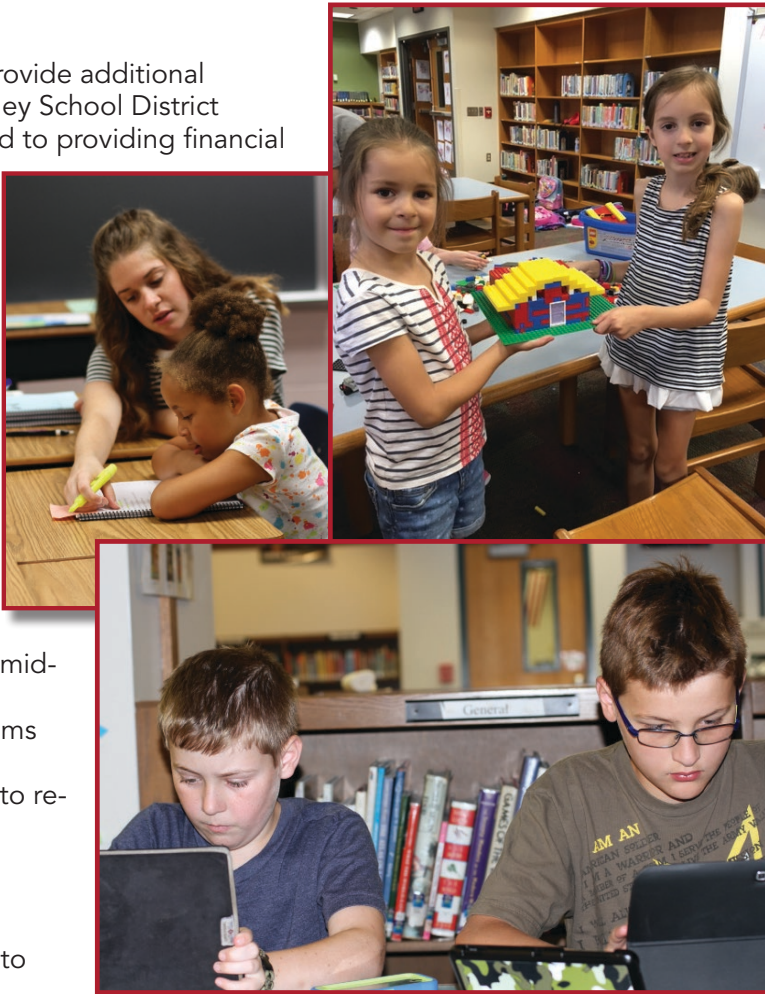

Eagle Enthusiasts \$5,000 or more	Donor recognition at the Eagle Enthusiast level, (4) tickets to the Spring musical^, plus (2) reserved seat tickets for 2017 home football games and (2) athletic passes*.
Gold Circle \$2,400 - \$4,999	Donor recognition at the Gold Circle level, (4) tickets to the Spring musical^, plus one reserved seat ticket for 2017 home football games and (2) athletic passes*.
Silver Circle \$1,000 – \$2,399	Donor recognition at the Silver Circle level, (2) tickets to the Spring musical^, plus one reserved seat ticket for 2017 home football games and (2) athletic passes*.
Bronze Circle \$500 – \$999	Donor recognition at the Bronze Circle level, (2) tickets to the Spring musical^, plus one reserved seat ticket for 2017 home football games and (2) athletic passes*.
Red & White Circle \$125 – \$499	Donor recognition at the Red & White Circle level, plus one reserved seat ticket for 2017 home football games and (2) athletic passes*.
Friends of CV \$1 – \$124	Recognized in the donor list; for a donation of \$100 or more you receive (2) athletic passes*.

To be included in the donor list within the football program, contributions must be received by **August 2, 2017**. Those eligible to receive athletic passes **will receive them in the mail** shortly after the contribution is recorded at the Foundation office.

If you take advantage of collecting your athletic passes and/or reserved home football tickets, you are ineligible to claim that portion of your contribution as a tax deduction since the value of the items exceeds your contribution. Contact your personal tax advisor for further details.

\* Athletic passes are good for admission to *regularly scheduled* home athletic events within the 2017-2018 season. Passes must be used by the individual whose name appears on the pass and cannot be transferred.

^ Includes premium reserved tickets to the spring musical (no ordering necessary). Musical tickets will be mailed to you in advance for one of the selected performances.
