The Military Legacy Scholarship recognizes a student who is a member of a “military family” on the basis of the applicant’s character, academic performance, service, and leadership, among other factors.

Each year the Eagle Foundation will award the Military Legacy Scholarship to a graduating Cumberland Valley High School senior who is the child of a parent or legal guardian in the active-duty military or a recent (within approximately four years) veteran of active-duty military service. Evidence of such service must be provided with the application in the form of a photocopy of a current military i.d., Form DD 214, or other acceptable proof of service. The scholarship will be a one-time award in the amount of \$2,500. The scholarship will be awarded during the Senior Night Awards ceremony in May in the form of a check made payable jointly to the student and academic institution. The scholarship money must be used for tuition payment to an accredited educational institution (two or four-year college or university, or a vocational or technical school) within one year of the award. The scholarship will be awarded to an applicant on the basis of broad criteria reflecting high character, good academic performance, volunteerism, service to CV and the community, leadership, and extra-curricular involvement, among other traits.
