Due to the length of the entire selection process, **LATE PACKETS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED REGARDLESS OF THE REASON!**

What are the membership requirements of the National World Language Honor Society?

Students become eligible upon completion of 3 consecutive years of study at the start of their 4th year of study (or start of year 5/6 if they have not previously qualified). Students must have a 93% overall UNWEIGHTED average for all previously studied levels of one specific World Language.

Students with special circumstances should speak with the World Language Department Supervisor for consideration (e.g. new students to the district who may have completed some language study in another district).

A fee of \$20 must be submitted ***once a student is approved for membership.***

Prior to and after induction, students may NOT have any disciplinary referrals for academic dishonesty, plagiarism, and/or cheating as referenced in the student handbook.

Upon acceptance for membership, current and upcoming members are required to complete the following three criteria in order to remain a member and receive an honor cord to be worn at graduation:

1. Continue studying a World Language (either continuing in the language of induction to the highest level possible, or pursuing study in a different World Language)
2. Maintain an overall 93% average (grades for Levels IV and higher may be averaged including weighting)
3. Complete a minimum of three different activities promoting World Language and/or culture per year through graduation.

A log of completed activities, including appropriate signatures, must be submitted on the provided form (available online) by the end of April for each year of membership. Possible activities may include:

- Attendance at the National World Language Honor Society Induction Ceremony
- Presentation at the National World Language Honor Society Induction Ceremony
- Peer tutoring (minimum of 1 hour)
- Active membership/participation in a language club
- Promotional activities for the larger student body (e.g. during National Foreign Language Week*)
- Participation in an optional World Language field trip, including some sort of presentation following the trip.
- Others as approved by World Language Staff

*Promotional Activities may NOT be required or graded as part of World Language study.

Other important notes on the selection process:

- Students who have a documented academic dishonesty violation by the teaching staff or administration will not be admitted into the NWLHS. Disciplinary referrals received after the selection process/induction will also be cause for immediate removal from the society membership.
- Students may be denied acceptance into NWLHS for any of the following reasons:
 - Handing in this application after the designated deadline
 - Falsifying information on this application
 - Incomplete or late paperwork, including missing signatures.

What is the timeline for selection?

The NWLHS selection process takes place each year during the first marking period. Each year, students will be notified of the status of their application at the start of the second marking period.
