

Copyright and Fair Use

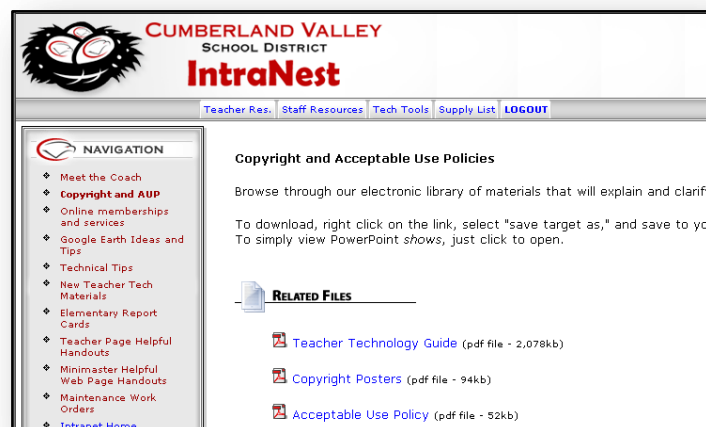

1. Log in to the Intranet at www.cvschools.org/intranet.
2. Click on the **Tech Tools** tab.
3. Click on the **Copyright and AUP** link in the left hand side navigation menu.
4. To download any of the files, right click on the link and select **Save Target As**. Save the file to your desired location on your computer.



5. To simply view any of the PowerPoint *shows*, just left click and select **Open**.
